The paper presents a list of fish species, which are classified according to Nelson. The collection is placed in the Prof. J. Wengris Museum of the Department of Zoology, Olsztyn University of Agriculture and Technology.

INTRODUCTION

The ichthyological collection makes a part of the Janina Wengris Museum which has been founded by the Department of Zoology at the Faculty of Water Protection and Inland Fisheries of the Olsztyn University of Agriculture and Technology. The fish collection sources date from 1965, when Prof. Dr Eugeniusz Grabda moved to Szczecin and Prof. Dr Maria Brylińska took over from him at the Faculty of Inland Fisheries.

A number of institutions helped to gather the collections, such as: Inland Fisheries Institute in Olsztyn (fishes of Iraq—Dr Julian Pyka), Sea Fisheries Institute in Gdynia (fishes collected during a research cruise of RN “Profesor Siedlecki”), University of Cantho—Vietnam (fishes of the Mekong River delta—Prof. Dr Mirosław Łuczyński), Limnological Institute of the Siberian Branch of the Academy of Sciences of the USSR (Baikal fishes), Academic Scuba-Diver’s Club “Scorpena” in Olsztyn (fishes of the Mediterranean and Red Sea—Dr Zbigniew Uggla and Dr Sławomir Boroń) and the J.L.B. Smith Institute of Ichthyology—Republic of South Africa (fishes of the Okavango delta). Dr Stanisław Danielewski had presented the Museum with a large collection of fishes from North Nigeria and South America, Prof. Dr W. Tesch had supplied the leptocephali of the European eel, ad Prof. Dr P.S. Economidis from the Aristotle University in Saloniki—fishes from Greek rivers.

The whole collection began when Prof. Janina Wengris had brought some specimens collected by the College of Rural Husbandry in Cieszyn. Prof. Dr Edmund Bryliński was the first donor of Polish fish species. Other exhibits were collected by the employees of the Department of Zoology, during their field studies. At first the fishes were prepared by Mr. Werner Kutritz, then by Mrs. Lucyna Żbikowska.

The large part of the collection (fishes of Africa) was systematised and defined by Imre (1995).

Currently the Museum possesses 527 fish exhibits belonging to 363 species

STRESZCZENIE

Muzeum im. Profesor Janiny Wengris przy Katedrze Zoologii posiada w swoich zbiorach 527 okazów ryb, należących do 363 gatunków. Są to głównie gatunki słodkowodne, w tym bardzo bogata kolekcja ryb afrykańskich.

Do powstania kolekcji przyczyniło się wielu ofiarodawców, m.in. Instytut Rybactwa Śródlądowego w Olsztynie, Morski Instytut Rybacki w Gdyni, University of Cantho z Wietnamu, Limnologiczny Instytut Syberyjskiego Wydziału Akademii Nauk ZSRR, Akademicki Klub Płetwonurków „Skorpена” z Olsztyna, J.L.B. Institute of Ichthyology z RPA oraz szereg osób: dr S. Boroń, prof. dr E. Bryliński, dr S. Danielewski, prof. dr P.S. Economidis, prof. dr M. Łuczyński, dr J. Pyka, prof. dr W. Tesch, dr Z. Uggla i inni.

Układ systematyczny i nazewnictwo wymienionych ryb oparte jest na systemie Nelsona (1994).
